ABOUT THE INCURSIONS

AWARE offers interactive, curriculum-aligned incursions to help students understand where waste goes, why getting it right matters, and the role they can play in improving waste and recycling at their school.

Following the waste audit, AWARE will provide one complimentary incursion for a minimum of two classrooms, with the most relevant activity recommended based on your school's waste audit results.

INCURSIONS:

BIN IT BETTER

Best suited to schools confused about which bin materials belong in.

Put students' waste knowledge to the test in an interactive game show featuring videos, pictures, multiple-choice questions and real prizes.

FEED THE GREEN BIN

Best suited to schools where food waste is being placed in the landfill bin instead of the FOGO bin. Students explore how food scraps become compost, why they should stay out of landfill, and test their knowledge in an interactive sorting activity.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

Best suited to schools that do not have a green bin or FOGO services (e.g. regional schools).

This hands-on workshop explores worms and composting as practical ways to keep food scraps out of landfill and turn them into nutrient-rich soil.

NEXT STEPS

From here, students will take their learning beyond the classroom through a tailored excursion, seeing waste and recycling systems in action and exploring where materials go after they leave their school.
